  - If food items are brought in, *they must be clearly marked with the date*. Also, please note that consumable items are only allowed for *personal consumption* and must be kept in the resident's room. Items will be monitored and will be disposed of upon expiration.
- We understand that families sometimes like to visit and enjoy their loved ones during mealtimes. *Unfortunately, family members are not allowed in our dining rooms.* If you would like to visit with your family during one of our mealtimes, separate space can be provided for you to do so. If you are interested in arranging such a time/space, please contact Salina (our Activity Director) or one of our Social Services team members.
