Mr. DeJong reported Cash on Hand would allow 66 days operation, which is suitable but lower than last year. There is an outstanding balance of 38 days of care yet to be collected. Revenue shows \$1M in lost revenue from 2021. Staffing struggles continue with 157 fulltime employees which is 4 down from prior years. In an attempt to retain employees - bonuses and raises were given to the staff. \$3.1M in purchased services was paid for Travel nurses. Traveler costs are 1 ½ times higher than Bethel employed individuals.

Statement of Operations and Changes in Net assets shows an operating loss of (\$2,511,465) in 2022 as compared to gain of \$1, 524,789 in 2021.

Mr. DeJong reviewed proposed adjustments including insurance claims, bad debt (the need to secure funding before admission).

Bethel's internal control policies do not meet standards required by the industry but have policies appropriate for an organization of this size.

The Chair entertained a motion to accept the financial report as presented. Motion was made and second. Motion carried.

Nomination of Board members: Aaron Schmit reviewed the current slate of Board members. There are three board positons open as Aaron has served 2 terms, Grant Carns did not wish to serve a second term and Ruth Carlson is eligible to serve a second term.

There were no other nominations from the floor.

Motion was made and seconded to cast unanimous ballot for the nominations of Jim McKenzie and Rob Osborn. Motion carried.

Motion was made and second to elect Ruth Carlson to a second term. Motion having been made and second, carried.

Chairman's Report: Aaron Schmit, BLNRC Board Chair, stating it was great to meet in person, presented the Chairman's report. Aaron spoke on the continuing challenges faced by Bethel. 2022 has been a difficult year for staff, residents and families. Lots of changes have taken place with Belinda Moen starting as Interim Administrator in January and being hired for that position in August. Additional new staff hired include a new CFO, new DON and new Assistant to Administrator. Bethel sustained a big loss and is hoping for approval of a government tax credit.

Eide Bailly conducted an Operational Assessment to determine areas where Bethel was efficient and inefficient. Much of the loss is attributed to the cost of employees, especially the traveling nurses. There is a trend where employed nurses leave fulltime positons to work for agencies. Nursing salaries were adjusted to be competitive.

Census - the number is lower due to the changing process of long term care.

A strategic planning retreat was held for board members to identify the positive and negative risks and identify ideas on how to find solutions.

Bethel recently signed a due diligence agreement for the purchase of land with the idea to build a new facility. The Facility Assessment conducted determined the current facility was beyond repair. EAPC architects will start looking for construction manager to walk thru the design phase. Results of the operational assessment are pending.

Administrators Report: Belinda Moen, Administrator, introduced herself and presented her report.

Staffing

Traveling nurses have been reduced from 37 at the highest level to 11 current contracted staff, which consists of 6 nursing assistants and 5 LPNs. Bethel has employed nurses from the Philippines, who enter into 3 year contracts to stay at Bethel.

Several key positions have been filled:

Tiffany Sickinger – CFO Jordan Wieth – Accountant Jill Wiedrich – Director of Nursing Kashia Ellis – Clinical Dietitian Amy Aamodt-Allenbrand – Assistant to Administrator and Social Media Director

Reduction in Number of Beds

Changes were made by laying away 38 beds. Bethel was licensed for 150 beds but averaging a census of 112 occupied beds. Government reimbursement requires nursing homes to maintain a 90% occupancy or take a reduction in funding; Bethel lost \$600K last year due the number of beds and occupancy levels.

Communication

Department meetings are now live. Clipboards with updated information were placed on all units with the employees being required to sign off they have read the information. An electronic scheduling process will be implemented in the next few months.

Accomplishments

Repairs from June 2021 hail storm were completed. Doors are once again open for visitation.

Belinda concluded her report by thanking the community; residents and staff, directors, and management at Bethel; the Foundation, the Board Members, the Building Committee and local churches for providing the much needed financial and spiritual support to our residents.

Adjournment:

A gift was presented to Aaron Schmit for his six years of service. In his closing comments, Aaron reflected on Bethel serving the community for the last 74 years. He expressed gratitude to staff who have served Bethel over the years and to the people who had the vision to make Bethel a reality. He thanked Bethel for the opportunity to serve.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:55 PM.

Minutes of Last Meeting - The minutes of the September 30, 2021, Annual meeting of Bethel Lutheran Foundation were presented for approval. The minutes were approved as printed.

Financial/Investment Report

Copies of the Annual report were distributed to all attendees and emailed to those attending by ZOOM.

Kurt Stoner, Foundation Director presented the financial report. Bethel Lutheran Foundation was audited by Brady Martz & Associates and received a Qualified Opinion. As explained in previous years, the reason for a Qualified Opinion is the mineral acres were not recorded at fair value at the time of donation and the Bethel Heritage Manor senior living apartments that were acquired from Williston Housing Partners, LP, were not recorded at fair value at the time of 100% ownership.

<u>Statement of Financial Position</u> - This document reflects 2021 total current assets of \$11,912,660 as compared to \$10,229,649 in 2020. Total liabilities of \$139,944 for 2021 compared to \$116,635 for 2020. Total net assets for 2021 were \$14,127,588 and total liabilities plus net assets were \$14,267,532.

<u>Statement of Activities</u> - This document reflects total support, revenue, and gains at \$2,515,483. The revenue was comprised mainly of \$617,234 of oil production, \$628,849 gross rental income and \$886,486 of net investment income. Donations to Bethel for 2021 were \$31,619. Bethel Foundation's senior living apartments and BLNRC are debt free.

Property and Equipment - 2021 financials show the minerals, land, building and improvements, furniture and fixtures were recorded at \$5,412,409 less accumulated depreciation of \$3,059,173 for net Property and Equipment of \$2,353,236.

Board designated endowment funds in the amount of \$5,981,331 consist of the oil and gas income invested at Ameriprise. All or part of these funds can be used at the Board's discretion for a building project. There is a Daycare Designated Fund of \$50,000. Permanent Endowment funds of \$1,130,861 are restricted by donors for a specific purpose. Included in these funds would be the Good Samaritan Fund in the amount of \$227,853 and the Building Fund in the amount of \$382.407.

The Chair entertained a motion to accept the financial report as presented. Motion was made and second. Motion carried.

Election of Board Members – Paula Jarland completed her second term on the Foundation Board.

Aaron Schmit, who completed two terms on the BLNRC Board, was nominated to serve a first term on the Foundation Board. There were no other nominations from the floor.

Motion was made and seconded to cast unanimous ballot for the nomination of Aaron Schmit. Motion carried.

Director's Report

The Director began his report by thanking Foundation employee Kathy Harger, Elaine Esterby, Golden Estates Manger and Gavin Pesek, Maintenance for their dedication and service.

Bethel would not exist without the leadership and dedication of the founding churches, and the individuals and donors that have supported Bethel from the inception. A listing of contributors for 2021 is included in the annual report.

Gifts of minerals made years ago contribute a large part of the revenue the Foundation currently receives. He thanked the Finance Committee and its members, Lowell Sandvik, Doug Crosby and Ron Lund. Another important group has been Bethel's Building Committee who have met for the past few years. The Committee consists of board members and volunteers Rick Tofte, Mark Schneider, Cindy Sorenson, Ken Kjos, Stuart Langager, Aaron Schmid, Joel Wilt and Bethel staff.

Mayor Howard Klug and the City of Williston were thanked for their support in the purchase of the future building project land in Williston Square and their past support of Bethel events such as College for Seniors.

In recapping his 31 years at Bethel, Kurt began his employment under the leadership of Wayne Hanson. Many of the staff at Bethel have made it their life calling and have carried for generations of the same family. Kurt plans to retire in April 2023, but plans to continue to assist with the Bethel Building Committee and be available as a resource for Bethel. Belinda Moen and her team were thanked for their leadership and encouraged on their work moving forward.

Kurt thanked Board members for their governance and everyone for their financial support as well as their prayers, donations of time and talent.

Planned Gift Tax Credit

An individual is allowed an income tax credit for making a charitable contribution in the form of a planned gift to either a qualified nonprofit organization or to a qualified endowment fund.

The credit is equal to 40% of the contribution, up to a maximum credit of \$10,000 (or \$20,000 if married filing a joint return). An adjustment must be made to increase North Dakota taxable income by the amount that the contribution reduced the individual's federal taxable income. If the credit exceeds the individual's tax in the tax year in which the contribution is made, the excess credit may be carried over and used on subsequent tax years' returns for up to 3 years.

Eligibility: A planned gift is a gift that qualifies as a charitable contribution for federal income tax purposes and is made using one of the following gifting methods:

- Charitable remainder unitrust (CRUT)
- Charitable remainder annuity trust (CRAT)
- Pooled income fund trust
- Charitable lead unitrust (CLUT)

- Charitable lead annuity trust (CLAT)
- Charitable gift annuity
- Deferred charitable gift annuity
- Charitable life estate agreement
- Donation of a paid-up life insurance policy

A qualified nonprofit organization is a tax-exempt charitable organization under federal income tax law that meets either of the following sets of criteria:

- It is incorporated or established in North Dakota and maintains a physical location in North Dakota.
- It is incorporated or established in a state bordering North Dakota; maintains a physical location outside North Dakota that is within 5 miles of a North Dakota city with a population of 5,000 or more that does not have a hospital; and supports or benefits a hospital, nursing home, medical center, or any combination of these.

A qualified endowment fund is a permanent, irrevocable fund that is:

- Held by a qualified nonprofit organization (or by a bank or trust company on behalf of the qualified nonprofit organization)
- Comprised of cash, securities, mutual funds, or other investment assets
- Established for a specific religious, educational, or other charitable purpose
- Only allowed to disburse the income from, or the increase in value of, the assets contributed to the fund

Filing Requirements: To claim the credit, complete Schedule ND-1PG and Schedule ND-1TC and include them with the North Dakota individual income tax return, Form ND-1.
