Construction of a pavilion for shade to protect pool patrons from the harmful rays of the sun in an effort to reduce skin cancer.

Sidney Svarre Municipal Pool \$2,652.00

Equipment to ensure the safety of pool patrons of all ages.

Boys & Girls Club of Richland County ... \$3,120.00

This project is to provide Positive Action curriculum and training to instill resilience and positive mental health and wellbeing with all age groups that attend the Boys & Girls Club.

Richland County Cancer Coalition..... \$2,934.00
